The library is open daily from 3:00pm until 16:30pm when the boys return from school. It is encouraging that the boys are taking ownership of the efficient running of the library.

- Shelter Program – providing youth care centre services that include schooling, accommodation, and support to boys between 8 and 18 years old
- Skills Centre – pottery and beadwork training and manufacture
- IT Centre – provide IT skills and basic education training to the boys who are not yet enrolled in school
- Outreach – provide meals to more than 150 people daily
- After Care – support to boys who were previously residing at Twilight Shelter
- Recreational and Sport Support
- Vegetable Garden
- Boys to Men Mentoring Project
